Careers in Medicine

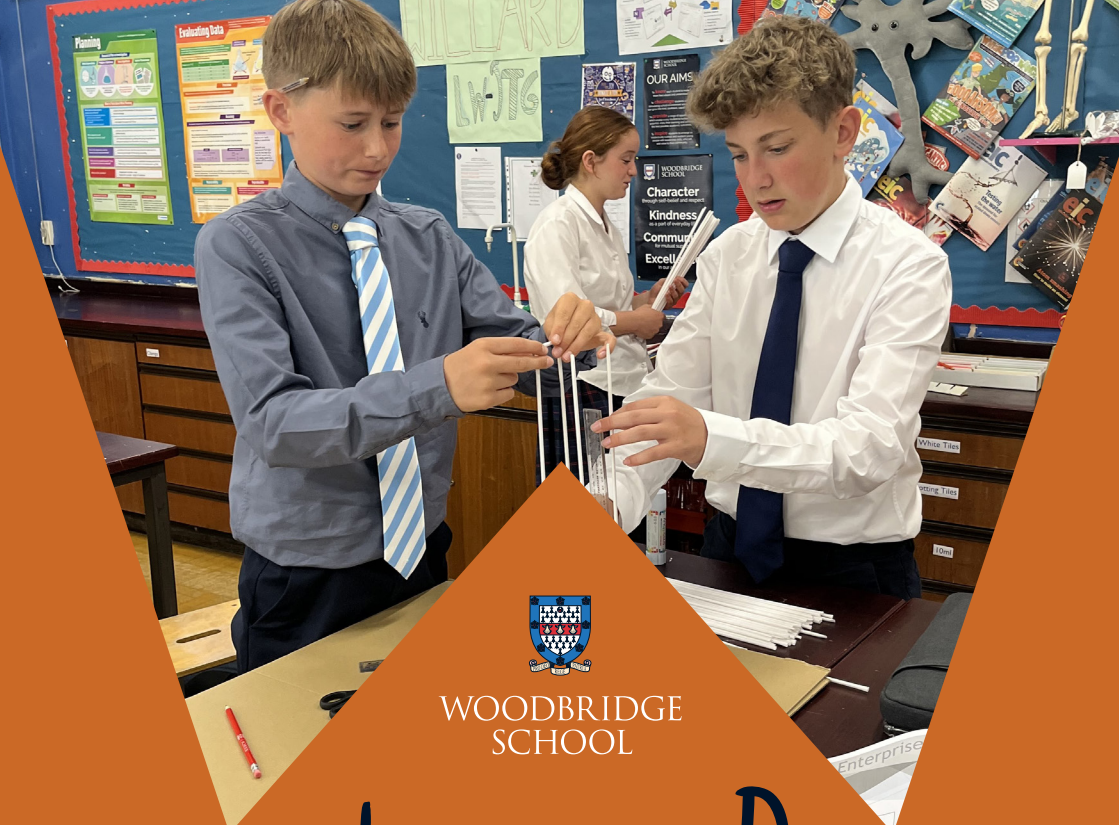
WEDNESDAY 30 APRIL 2025, 1.30PM - 3.00PM

Supported by the EDF Sizewell B team

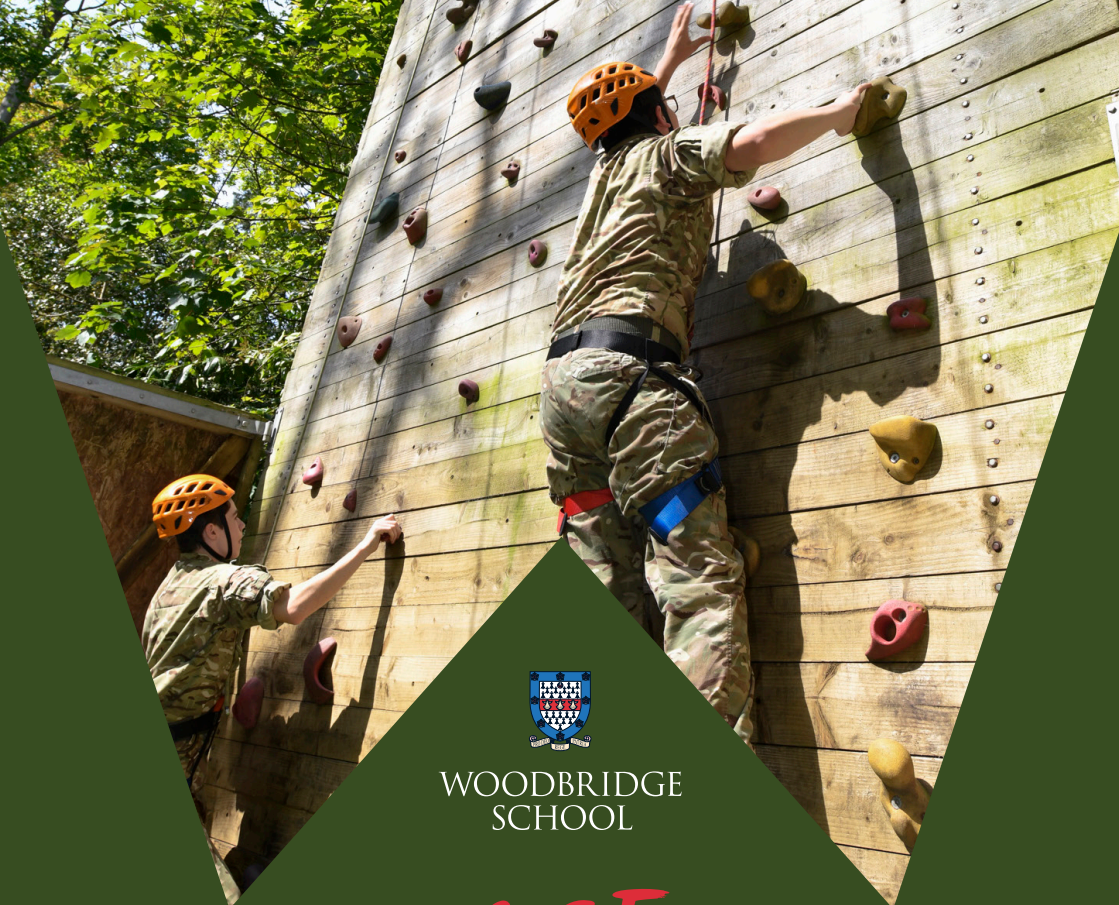
MONDAY 12 MAY 2025, 9.30AM – 2.30PM
